Bankrupt Estate of Scot Gordon Young (Deceased)


I have been informed by Victoria Edgar that following the release of Mr. David Ingram on 20th October 2020, the Official Receiver in Birmingham is now the Ex-Officio Trustee of the above named who was my former husband.

Prior to his bankruptcy in 2010, Mr. Young was possessed of substantial assets and I believe that his bankruptcy was in part engineered to deprive me of a just settlement in respect of divorce proceedings. In April 2010, the High Court awarded me inter alia, monthly maintenance payments of £27,500 but these were never paid by Mr. Young. In 2013, the High Court sentenced Mr. Young to six months of imprisonment for contempt of court because he refused to reveal information regarding his financial circumstances. Despite this, in November 2013, the High Court awarded me £26,600,000 and 50% of Mr. Young's estate, not a penny of which have I ever received.

Ten years on since Mr. Young's bankruptcy I have been unable to elicit any meaningful information regarding his financial position, nor what his Trustees in bankruptcy (Messrs. Ingram & Hicken) did to trace assets that may have been disposed of unlawfully in the run up to his bankruptcy, nor details of any realisations and distributions they may have achieved. Moreover, his Trustees attempted to deprive me of the proceeds of a life policy written in trust in my favour by holding out that these formed parts of Mr. Young's estate. Any trustee with a modicum of competence would have known this could not have been the case.

I am relieved that you have replaced Mr. Ingram because I am confident that you will provide me with information that he has consistently and steadfastly declined to do. In due course, I would like you to provide me with copies of all the former Trustees' records but appreciate this will take some time, so initially would you please send me copies of the Trustees' Reports to Creditors which will include inter alia, what actions they took to trace assets, what realisations they achieved, what distributions they made and the fees they paid themselves.
